## 22 CULTURAL HERITAGE

# **22.1 RULES**

### **Permitted Activities**

- Any repair or maintenance of buildings or sites identified in <u>Schedule 1</u>, but does not include:
  - any alteration, addition, removal or demolition of the heritage fabric; and
  - any repair using materials that are different from existing ones.
- Any trimming of a notable tree identified in <u>Schedule 1</u>, provided it is undertaken by a qualified arborist, excluding for existing utilities where the trimming of notable trees identified in <u>Schedule 1</u> and associated with the activities listed in <u>Section 26.5.1(1)</u> can be undertaken by a contractor.
- Removal of wind-thrown trees, diseased trees or standing dead trees identified in <a href="Schedule1">Schedule 1</a>, that have become dangerous to human life or property, or have died as a result of natural causes.

### **Controlled Activity**

22.1.4 Any internal alteration or addition to a building listed in <u>Schedule 1</u>.

## **Discretionary Activity**

- 22.1.5 Any external alteration or addition to a building listing in Schedule 1.
- The relocation, demolition or destruction (partial or total), of any heritage resource listed in <a href="Schedule 1">Schedule 1</a>.
- Any land disturbance occurring in any defined area of significance to tangata whenua identified in <a href="Schedule 1">Schedule 1</a>.
- 22.1.8 Any activity not provided for as a permitted or controlled activity.
