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FORM OF INDEMNITY

In c	onsideration of the Council permitting me to erect a temporary fence on a length of metres
on t	he roadside adjoining my property described as
	fronting the Road.
l ag	ree as follows:
1.	THAT the fence is to be stock proof and of a temporary nature only and is to be erected not closer than three metres from the edge of the gravel on a graveled road or three metres from the edge of the seal on a sealed road.
2.	THAT the fence may not be erected as to enclose both sides of a road reserve without special authority from the Council and if a fence already encloses the opposite side of the road the permit is inoperative until referred back to Council for confirmation.
3. 4.	NO trees or hedges may be planted on that portion of the road reserve within the fence. THAT I will paint the corner or end posts white.
5. 6.	THAT I will clear and keep clear all noxious weeds up to the middle line of the road reserve. THAT I will not plough the road flank until I have applied and received from the Council, permission to carry out such work.
7. 8.	THAT the said fence may remain in position until or at the pleasure of Council. THAT I and my successors in Title shall completely remove the said fence back to the proper boundary without any claim on the Council, if, at any time prior to the abovementioned date, the Council so requests.
9.	IF the encroachment encloses the existing road drain or water table the drain or water table then becomes the responsibility of the property owner to keep clean to the Roading Manager's satisfaction. Failure to comply with this clause could cause Council to insist on the removal of the fence back to the proper boundary.
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
