Voting papers for local government elections will be arriving in your mailboxes over the next week and it's important that you complete and return your voting papers as soon as possible.

We have all heard the stories of the last minute rush to the James Baty-Electoral Officer, post box, so don't leave it too late. It's so much easier

to have your voting papers completed as soon as you receive them. Saves all the last minute rushing around.

There might be some of you that still haven't made up your minds about who to vote for or you might still need some information about the Māori Wards poll. I think the main point is don't leave your vote till the very last minute.

Also-if you damage, misplace or believe your voting form has been lost in the post, you can still cast a special vote. Just come in and see either myself or Trudy Clark at the Wairoa District Council offices in Queen Street and we'll be able to assist you.

You can post your completed forms at PostShop or any post box around the district. We will also have a ballot box located in our Queen street office as well. Make sure your friends and family have sent off their forms as well.

The Wairoa district had the second highest voter turnout in the country in the last elections and we want to take out the top spot this round. So it's really important that you have your say, cast your vote and make sure you send your voting forms back well before the deadline of 8 October for it to be counted. Don't leave it till the last minute.
